Sermon: 'Heroes and Sheroes follow Jesus!'

Scripture

Hero Hotline Scripture Memory Verse Romans 14: 19

So let's strive for the things that bring peace and the things that build each other up.

John 1: 35-51 VBS Translation Response
We will follow (stomp stomp)
Jesus (pat pat).
We will follow (clap clap)
Love (cross arms over heart).

John the Baptist (wave) was standing with two of his disciples, Andrew and another one-we don't know that one's name. When John the Baptist saw Jesus walking by and said-"Look The Lamb of God." John's two disciples started to follow Jesus instead of John.

Response

When Jesus turned and saw them he asked "What are you looking for?" The disciples said "Rabbi, where are you staying?" Jesus said, "Come and see."

Response


Nathaniel was impressed and chose to follow Jesus too.
