HOIR Notes from Jann

Music Moments

Silent Night is one of my favorite Christmas carols. It was composed in 1818 in the small town of Salzburg.

Joseph Mohr, a young Catholic priest, came to Oberndorf bei Salzburg (about 11 miles north of Salzburg) in 1817 in the aftermath of the Napoleonic wars. The melody was composed by Franz Xaver Gruber, an organist in the nearby town of Arnsdorf. Mohr wanted the song for the Christmas Eve mass but flooding had destroyed the organ. So the $1^{\rm st}$ rendition of this carol was on a guitar.

Karl Mauracher, an organ builder who serviced the organ at that church loved the song and took it with him. He shared it with two traveling folk singers. The carol spread everywhere. The first US performance was in NYC in 1839.

A manuscript was discovered in 1995 in Mohr's handwriting, dated 1820. It states that Mohr wrote the words in 1816 and the music was composed by Gruber in 1818. Prior to this, people assumed a famous composer had written the melody! Today the lyrics and melody are in the public domain.

One line of the poem was translated - Round you Virgin mother and child, Holy infant so tender and mild but one translator: Round you godly tender pair Holy infant with curly hair - which is actually closer to the original poem.

It has been translated in about 300 languages.

At the TRUMC Parlor of the Family Life Center at 6:30 PM led by Pastor Christine and Pastor Brian.


We will meet on November 28th, December 5th, and December 12th.


