Trumpets

During March, we remember St. Patrick who used a shamrock to help understand the Trinity: God—the loving Parent, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit. The shamrock's shape lends itself to learning about God! Help young singers to continue to know who God is as you explore with them and all of us at TRUMC this wonderful mystery of faith. "The Irish botanist and cleric Caleb Threlkeld wrote about Ireland's native plants in 1726 that explained the shamrock as the country's national symbol, and asserted its significance in the context of St. Patrick's Day. Threlkeld wrote: 'This Plant is worn by the People in their Hats upon the 17th Day of March yearly, (which is called St. Patrick's Day.)' Continuing to explain why the plant was relevant that day, specifically, Threlkeld said, 'It being a Current Tradition, that by this Three Leafed Grass, he emblematically set forth to them the Mystery of the Holy Trinity."
