- Who's saint are you?

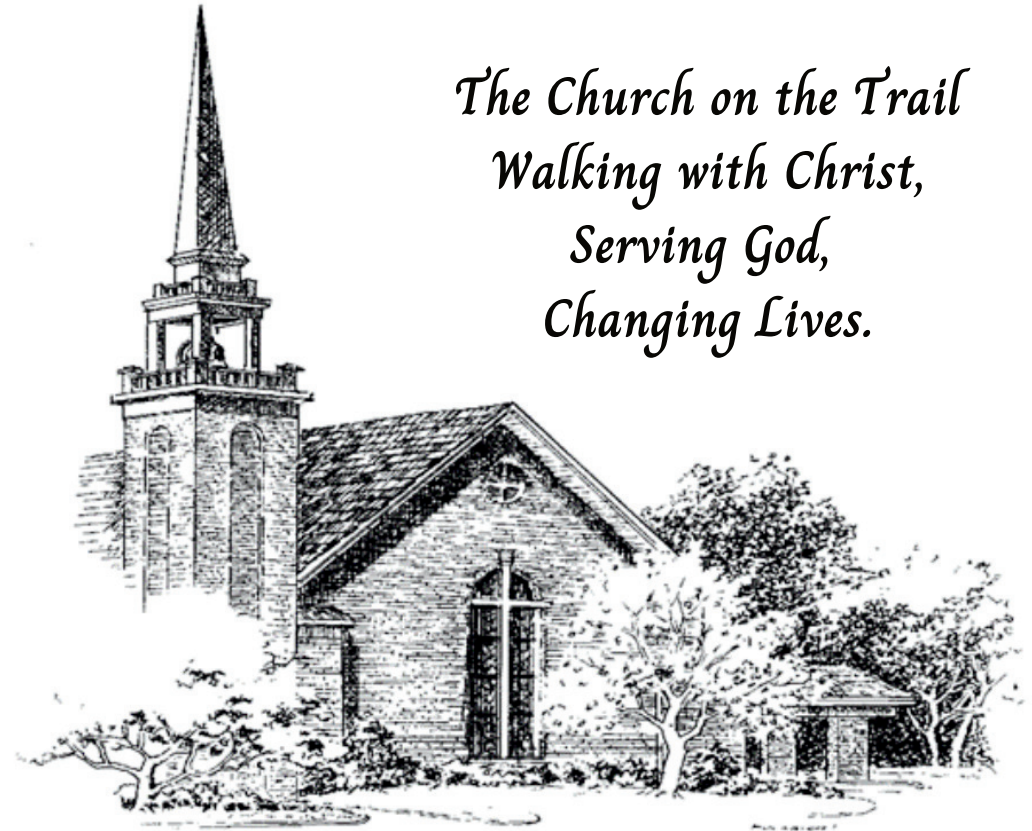
Prayer for the Week
